

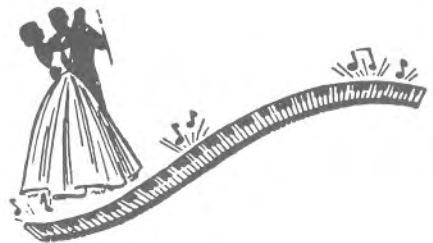

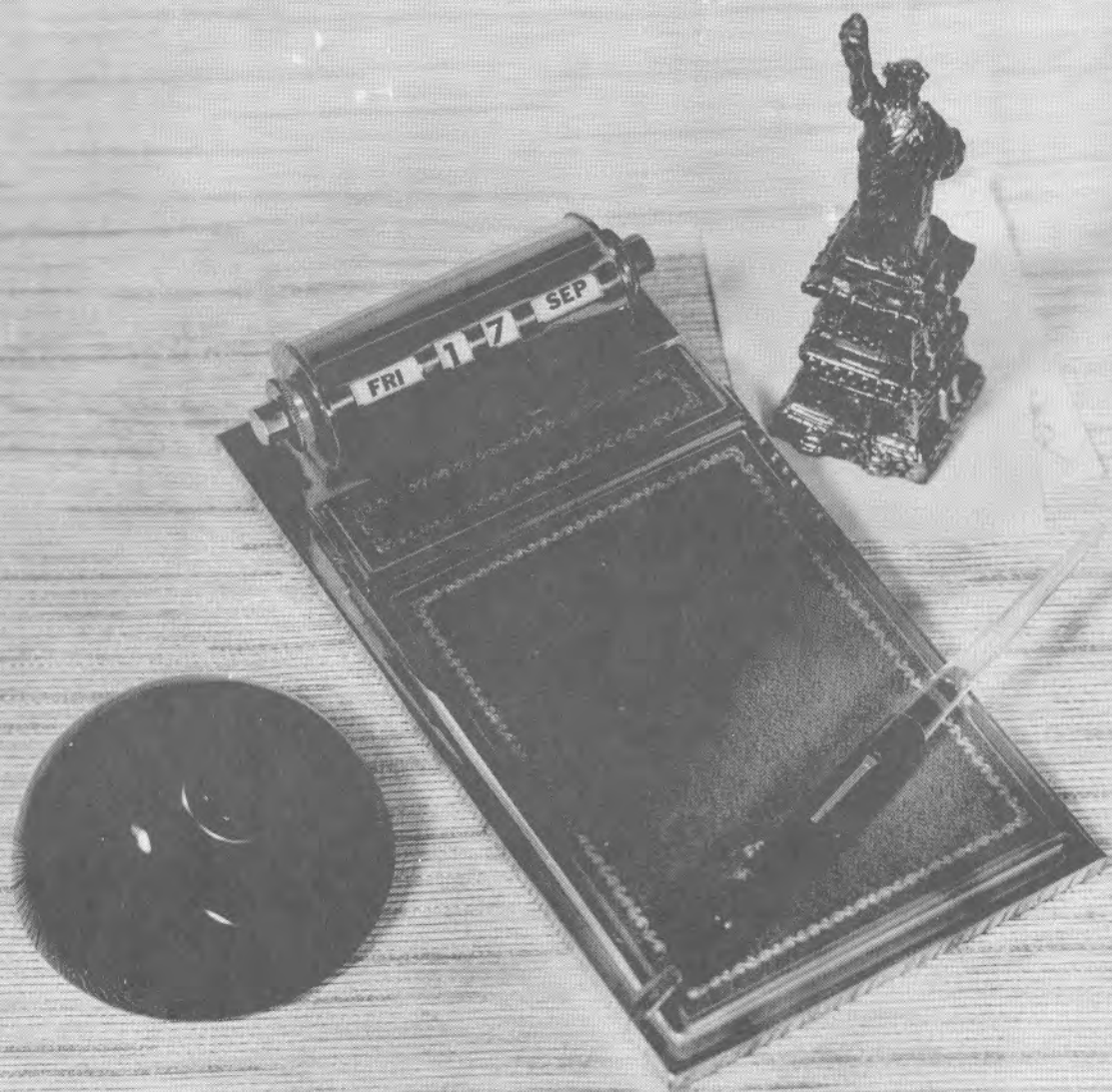
MR. LOW
