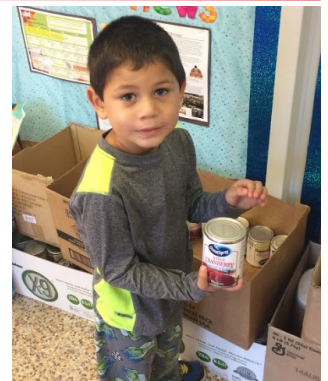
1st GRADE CHRISTMAS PROGRAM
