KINDERGARTEN OPEN HOUSE and REGISTRATION

It is time to think KINDERGARTEN! We are offering a new process for starting kindergartners. Please read the following carefully.

We will be hosting Kindergarten an Open House and Registration on Thursday, March 1st from 6-7:30pm. If you have a child who will be five years old by August 1st, 2018, please plan on attending! Incoming kindergarten students and parents will have the opportunity to meet the teachers, complete registration paperwork, and walk through the kindergarten classrooms. Appointments for kindergarten screening may be made at open house/registration or by calling the school office at (330) 859-2461. Kindergarten Screening will be held on May 29th and 30th.

When attending Open House and Registration, please bring the following paperwork with you. These documents are all required in the Kindergarten registration process.

- Birth Certificate
- Social security Card
- Immunization Record
- Proof of Residency (utility bill or lease agreement)
- Custody Papers (if applicable)

OFFICE REMINDERS



As the temperatures turn cold, please make sure to have your child dressed for outside recess. Hats, gloves, scarves and warm coats are suggested. We will be allowing students to go outside for recess if the temperature and wind chill are above 20 degrees. Many of the small articles of clothing and outerwear are often dropped or misplaced during the winter months. To assist in locating lost items, please place your child's name on all items.

During this cold and flu season, be sure to call the school if your child will not be attending for the day. A note is required by the parent or physician (if applicable) upon the student's return to school. If the student will be out for two or more days, school work can be gathered for you to pick up. Please let the office know prior to 11am in order to give time for the teacher to gather work and write out assignments. Work can then be picked up in the office after 2:00.
