- Instruction in Economics and Financial Literacy
- Instruction in CPR
- Total Credits Required
 - 22.5
- Fine Art
 - 2 semesters
 - can be met in 7th or 8th (Band, Choir, Adv Art)
 - HS Courses- Art, Choir, Select Choir, Band, Hx of Rock & Roll, Beg. Guitar, and Art Appreciation- TAA

PE Waiver

- Students may opt to apply for PE Waiver in lieu of 2 PE courses
- Waiver can be completed through athletics, including cheer, and marching band.
- Waiver must include 2 seasons of an activity.
- Both activities, and the waiver form, must be completed by end of sophomore year, or student will be scheduled in PE courses held in school.

CBIP

- Freshman and Sophomore Instructor Mr. Mike Recktenwalt
- Career Based Intervention (CBI) consists of a Related period and a Work Block.
- The Related period is where you learn job readiness skills, resume writing, interviewing skills, and the basics of business.
- The Work Block is where you will work either in the school or in a job outside of the school to earn credits.

- Students with Individual Education Plans (IEPs)

Pathways to Graduation

1. Accumulate 18 points on End of Course Exams
2. Earn a remediation free score on the ACT/SAT
3. Earn a State Board of Education- approved, industry-recognized credential or a state issued license for practice in a career and achieve a score that demonstrates workforce readiness and employability on a skills assessment.

End of Course Exams

- Must accumulate a minimum of 18 points
- End of Course Exams:
 - English I & English II
 - Must accumulate 4 points in subgroup
 - Algebra I & Geometry
 - Must accumulate 4 points in subgroup
 - Biology, American History, & Am Govt
 - Must accumulate 6 points in subgroup

- The state of Ohio will pay for all 11th-grade students in the Class of 2018 and beyond to take the exam free of charge.

Industry Credential

- Typically occurs within our partnership with Buckeye Career Center.
- Students will review credentialing options with the career technical school's guidance department during the scheduling process their junior and senior years if participating in a CTE program.

Community Service

16 hours of required community service

- Potential to earn credit, depending on number of community service hours completed:
 - 30 hours= $\frac{1}{4}$ credit
 - 60 hours= $\frac{1}{2}$ credit
 - 120 hours=1 credit

Community Service Cont.

- Must be a non-profit organization
- Student cannot be related to his/her supervisor
- Two part process
 - BEFORE--approval signature ON FORM from counselor OR principal
 - AFTER--written reflection required

Scheduling Process

1. Read through course guide (found on TV guidance website)— what are your options?
2. Scheduling for courses will be done 1 on 1 at the middle school with Mrs. Dickerhoof and Mrs. McElwee using a TVHS scheduling card.

Scheduling Cont.

- 8th grade teachers will make recommendations to assist the guidance department in course placement.
- Teachers reserve the right to recommend or to not recommend a student for a specific course.

Scheduling Cont.

- 4 Core classes are required
- Additional proposed Freshman courses :
 - P.E./PE Waiver
 - Health (1/2 credit)
 - Intro to Adobe Photoshop (1/2 credit)
 - All three proposed courses are required prior to admittance for CTE.

Keep in mind when Scheduling...

- 9 periods in the day
 - 1 lunch period
 - 5 ½ periods will be filled with required courses
- Can not have more than 2 total study halls

Athletic Eligibility

- OHSAA
 - must be passing 5 courses (PE does not count) the 9 weeks prior to your season and the 9 weeks during season
 - We recommend scheduling 6 or more courses
 - TVHS GPA required: 1.7
- NCAA
 - NCAA approved courses
 - See guidance for eligibility and process

Scheduling Cont.

3. Take your scheduling card home, review your selections with parent(s)/guardian(s)

4. Parent and student signatures are a must!!!

- Schedules will be handed out early April.
- Schedule changes are sometimes necessary in high school due to class conflicts; though please remember schedule changes are not made because of superfluous requests.

Schedule Change Policy

- Changes in your schedule must be made before the upcoming school year begins. Changes are to be made in April (window to be announced).
THERE WILL BE NO SCHEDULE CHANGES IN THE FALL.
- Per 2nd semester courses, no pupil shall drop a class after the first 3 days of the 2nd semester. After the first 3 days of semester 2, a drop of any course regardless of program, or location, will result in an “WF” for the semester/year.
